Please Note:

1. A **napkin and handkerchief** are to be sent daily. An **extra pair of clothes** must be kept in the child's bag.
2. All belongings of the child must be **clearly labelled with his/her name.**
3. **Five sharpened pencils, one eraser and a box of plastic crayons** are to be sent to school daily.

4. **Fun with English, Rhythmic Rhyme Book and Akshar Parichay** are to be brought to school **every day**.
5. Activity worksheets sent home should be **taken out of the bag and properly filed**.
6. Every student must reach the school **at least 5 minutes before the bell** to attend the assembly.
7. In case a student is **frequently late**, he/she will not be permitted to attend the class.
8. The **school diary must be brought regularly** to enable communication between teachers and parents. Parents must **fill in the first page of the diary without fail**.
9. Distribution of **birthday cake or return gifts is not permitted**. Parents may send **biscuits or donate a book to the school library** on their ward's birthday.
10. **Half-day leave will not be sanctioned** under any circumstances. Parents are requested to avoid such requests.
11. In case of absence, parents must **fill the leave note in the student's diary**, without which the student will not be permitted to attend school.
12. **Junk food is not permitted** in the school tiffin. Only **home-cooked food** should be given.
13. Avoid sending **fancy stationery items, money or valuables**. The school will not be responsible for the loss of such items.
14. **Saturday will be a holiday** for students of the Pre-primary Section.
15. Any change in **transport or mode of pick-up** will be considered **only through written communication**.
